INFO PACK

Arrival in Rome (Fiumicino Airport – FCO)

Participants arriving at Fiumicino Airport can easily reach the city centre.

The most convenient option is the **Leonardo Express**, a direct train linking the airport to Roma Termini in about 32 minutes. Trains run frequently throughout the day and tickets cost approximately €14.

Bus shuttles to the city centre are also available and generally take between 45 and 60 minutes depending on traffic.

Taxis operate with a fixed fare of €50 for rides to central Rome; official taxis are white and clearly marked with the “TAXI” sign and Rome’s emblem.

Accommodation

Each participant is responsible for booking their own hotel. To ensure smooth travel to the meeting locations—Via Guidubaldo del Monte and Corso Vittorio Emanuele II—we recommend choosing accommodation close to **Metro Line A**.

Areas such as Termini, Repubblica, Barberini, Spagna, Ottaviano, Lepanto and Flaminio are all located along Metro Line A, which is the line most useful for reaching the meeting venues. Metro Line A connects the main transport hub of Roma Termini with the historic centre and the Prati/Flaminio area, offering fast and direct travel across the city.

Local Transport

Rome’s public transport network combines **metro, buses** and **trams**. Standard tickets cost €1.50 and are valid for 100 minutes; day passes are also available. Tickets can be purchased at metro stations, newsstands and automatic machines.

Meals

Meals during the visit will be at the expense of each own delegation.

On 15 December, a light lunch will be available near the activity venue, and the delegation is welcome to join the Italian participants if they wish.

Dinner on 15 December and lunch on 16 December are not organised centrally; each delegation will make its own arrangements independently.

The meeting areas are well served by cafés and restaurants, so finding suitable options nearby is easy.
